

Possible Job Scams

Look for the warning signs

Job offers on which you shouldn't apply

The hiring manager or employer contacts you first, usually by stating that they found your resume online or through an email.





You receive a job offer right away

An immediate work offer from an organisation combined with the fact that you didn't contact the company first can mean the job opportunity isn't as legitimate as it seems.

The pay is extremely high

If you notice a high-income level for the position or the offered salary does not justify with job description/ level of work, it may be a warning sign





Unprofessional Communication

Another big warning sign of an illegitimate job is its unprofessional communication i.e. grammatical and sentence formation mistakes, contact through WhatsApp/Facebook and not through official email addresses.

The company requires payment

from you

No legitimate job opportunity will require you to pay to work for the company.
