

Raising awareness on migration through media reporting



ICMPD with the technical support of the Ethical Journalism Network (EJN), UK have held several consultative workshops with leading media outlets of Pakistan to draft the first migration reporting guidelines and migration reporting tool kit for the Pakistani media. This was followed by a comprehensive training on media and migration reporting with 20 journalists/ media personal working across the country. A publication event was organised in December to showcase the stories of successful fellows e and depict the work they have under gone with the mentorship provided by the EJN.
