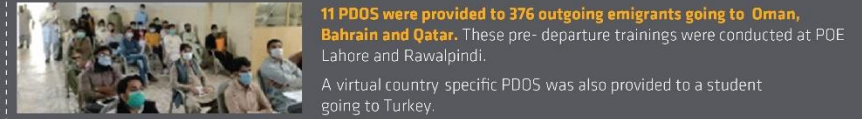

Parliamentary Roundtable on Migration from Pakistan



MRC and PIPS jointly organised the first virtual **"Parliamentary Roundtable on Migration from Pakistan"** on **19 March 2021**. The event brought together 12 participants from MDPHRD. Parliamentary members from the standing committee of the Senate of Pakistan and the National Assembly, civil society and subject experts.

The discussion brought forward several recommendations-

- Parliamentarians should collaborate with the MRC to raise awareness on migration in their home communities. As public figures and ambassadors of their communities, their voices are well received and acknowledged.
